Criteria for practitioners to be considered suitably qualified to provide second opinion ultrasound assessment of the fetus in cases with high risk or previously abnormal findings

Criteria:

- Maternal and fetal medicine specialist,
 - With focus on fetal medicineOR
- Obstetrician / general practitioner, with
 - Further training in O&G ultrasound (equivalent of two years full time training), or
 - Fetal Medicine Foundation accreditations (e.g. echocardiography, diploma in fetal medicine), or
 - Virtual fetal medicine fellowship (Barcelona)

AND

- Regular attendance of and active participation in local (and preferably international) CPD events in fetal medicine

AND

- In private practice with primary focus on fetal medicine / high risk obstetrics,
- OR
- In tertiary fetal medicine unit

AND

- Current member of SASUOG

AND

- Agrees to be on list for second opinion referrals
